

## **Mayor Henrici Seeks Applicants for Town Boards and Commissions**

**Hamden:** Mayor Craig Henrici is requesting Hamden residents interested in volunteering to serve on the Fair Rent Commission to send a letter of interest and a resume to Town Clerk Vera Morrison, 2750 Dixwell Avenue, Hamden, CT 06518. At this time, a Tenant representative and an Alternate Landlord representative that are not members of the Democratic Party are needed. The Fair Rent Commission meets as needed on the fourth Tuesday of each month at the Government Center at 5pm.

There are 33 volunteer Boards and Commissions in Hamden. A complete list may be obtained from the Town Clerk's Office. Availability on Commissions occurs when terms expire or volunteers resign. The lengths of terms vary from Commission to Commission, but most are three years. Town ordinances require that Boards and Commissions include representatives of more than one political party. The majority of the Boards and Commissions meet one evening each month, but some do meet during business hours.

Openings exist or are anticipated soon on the following boards:

Cable Advisory Council meets on the first Wednesday of each month at the CTV Offices on State Street. Meetings are during the evening and are televised. Hamden has an opening for a representative to Citizens Television.

The Clean and Green Com-

mission meets on the third Monday of each month at 7:30pm at the Government Center. Clean and Green needs two members that are interested in helping with their projects, which include several cleanups, welcome packets for new residents, assisting with Earth Day events, etc.

The Community Development Citizens Advisory Commission is in need of three new members. Their meetings are held at 5:30pm on the second Wednesday of each month at the Keefe Center.

The Commission on Disability Rights & Opportunities is in need of one new member. This Commission meets on the second Monday of each month at 7pm in the Friends Room at Miller Library.

The Energy Use & Climate Change Commission is in need of one new member that is not a registered Democrat. Their meetings are held at the Hamden Government Center at 7pm on the third Monday of each month.

The Human Rights & Relations Commission is currently working on Affirmative Action and Affordable Housing and is seeing a new member. The HRRC meets on the second Thursday of every month at 7pm at the Government Center.
